Assisted Technology Use

The Port Edwards School District recognizes that educational technology is a valued resource for students and teachers in the implementation of the District curriculum. The District believes that all students, regardless of disability or special needs, should have access to educational technologies, including but not limited to, instructional television, computer technology and telecommunications.

The Port Edwards School District will make available assistive technology devices or assistive technology services, or both, to a child with a disability if required as part of the child's special education, related services, or supplementary aids and services. If a child's individualized education program team determines that access to school-purchased assistive technology devices or services in the child's home or in other settings is necessary for the child to receive a free appropriate public education, the devices or services will be provided.

The successful utilization of these technologies requires the responsibility of each staff member and student to use these tools for the express purpose of learning within the context of District curricula.
