STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES ON SCHOOL BOARD

A student representative, or representatives, to the school board shall be selected annually to keep Student Council informed of Board of Education activities and report to the Board on Student Council activities and concerns.

1. Any student can be a candidate for School Board representative. The Student Council and principal, after interviewing interested students, will choose the students they feel will be able to represent the student body in a mature manner.
2. Student representatives cannot attend closed meetings.
3. Student representatives cannot discuss financial matters or make a complaint(s) about a faculty member.
4. Student representatives cannot vote on School Board decisions.
5. Student representatives should attend all Student Council meetings, if possible.
6. Student representatives must have administrative approval before taking matters of interest to the school board.

The keys to serving as an effective student representative on the school board are maturity and good judgment. Student representatives should be able to express his or her thoughts well, and be open minded about discussions and decisions.
